- Write a minimum one-page essay describing why the community service was meaningful to you and how the skills you have obtained through community service could help you in the future. Include how you have encouraged others to volunteer.
- Provide a letter of recommendation from a teacher or counselor.
- Include a current high school transcript from your counselor.

Please note the following:

- Applications will not be returned.
- Notification will be sent to students via email by **Spring Break**.
- Upon receiving an award, students will need to provide proof of enrollment in a post-secondary institution to the Foundation by **July 1, 2021**.
- All awards will be distributed directly to the post-secondary institution.
- All awards need to be claimed by **October 1, 2021**. Any unclaimed awards by that time will be lost and may be re-allocated to another student.
