



Rosella and Hugo Sickinger Memorial Scholarship

2021-2022 School Year | Due: Friday, Dec. 10, 2021

The Peoria Education Foundation's Rosella and Hugo Sickinger Memorial Scholarship is intended for graduating female students that demonstrated character, citizenship, poise and respect for contemporaries at all levels of contacts and relationships, as well as demonstrate intense motivation to perform academically, beyond the ACT/SAT test.

Students who apply must plan to attend a post-secondary institution including a university, community college or a vocational/trade school to further their education.

The Rosella and Hugo Sickinger Memorial Scholarship cannot exceed \$1,000 per year but can continue for three additional years if the recipient: 1) Continues to have credible academic standing, 2) Progresses on scheduling their ultimate goals and 3) Continues with their original school of choice.

All scholarships awarded will be made payable to the recipient's chosen college, university or vocational/ trade school upon confirmation of enrollment.

Section I: Scholarship Requirements

A completed application needs to be submitted with a letter of recommendation from a school counselor or administrator stating how this applicant demonstrates qualities that would serve as an example or role model to others. Letter of recommendation should not exceed one page.

Nominees should meet the following criteria:

Graduating female students that demonstrated character, citizenship, poise and respect for contemporaries at all levels of contacts and relationships, as well as demonstrate intense motivation to perform academically, beyond the ACT/SAT test.

Timeline:

- Notification will be sent to students via email by **Spring Break**.
- Upon receiving an award, students will need to provide proof of enrollment in a post-secondary institution to pusdpr@pusd11.net by **July 1, 2022**.
- All awards will be distributed directly to the post-secondary institution, not the student.
- All awards need to be claimed by **October 1, 2022**. Any unclaimed awards by that time will be lost and may be re-allocated to another student.

*NOTE: Incomplete Applications will NOT be considered.
