

Peoria Future Farmers of America Baskett Scholarship Cover Sheet

The Peoria Education Foundation is a non-profit 501(c)3 organization that provides grants to teachers and scholarships to students within the Peoria Unified School District. The Foundation's **Peoria Future Farmers of America (FFA) Baskett Scholarship** is intended for Peoria Unified seniors who have participated in FFA a minimum of two semesters during their high school career.

Students who apply must plan to attend a post-secondary institution including a university, community college or a vocational/trade school. The amount of each award varies and is subject to approval from the Foundation Board.

All scholarships awarded will be made payable to the recipient's chosen college, university or vocational/ trade school for educational-related expenses.

Students who are granted scholarships will be invited to attend the annual Scholarship Reception with their family in the spring hosted by the Foundation Board.

Section I: Peoria FFA Baskett Scholarship Application Requirements

- Students who apply must be enrolled in a Peoria Unified high school.
- Students who apply must have participated in FFA a minimum of two semesters during high school.
- Students who are awarded scholarships must plan to attend a post-secondary institution (Ex. a university, community college or a vocational/trade school).
- All applications should include a completed letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, or school administrator stating how this applicant demonstrates qualities that are a strong fit for this scholarship.
- All scholarship applications must include an unofficial transcript from your counselor to be considered complete.
- All scholarship applications should include the essay requirements detailed below.
